## Our Focus

Every child has opportunities to participate in arts and crafts, music & movement, science projects, group games, organized sports, cooking activities, swimming and fieldtrips.

## Our Staff

With our low counselor to camper ratio of 1:9, our staff can offer lots of hands-on opportunities to your child. We place emphasis on getting to know each member of the group while simultaneously teaching teamwork by building community spirit. All counselors are fingerprinted and have gone through CPR/First Aid training.

## Our Schedule

Little Bridges Summer Camp has put together the perfect schedule for school age kids. We alternate between structured activities like academic review, book time and journal writing along with summertime traditions like crafts, organized games, swimming, free time and field trips. Campers explore a new park every Monday, swim every Tuesday and Thursday, travel by chartered bus every Wednesday for a weekly field trip and spend Fridays on site participating in specially planned activities.

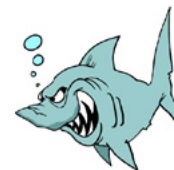
